Abacavir

Other Names: ABC, Abacavir sulfate

Class: Antiretrovirals

Zidovudine

Generic Name: AZT; ZDV, Zidovudine

Class: Antiretrovirals

Study 1 of 2

Abacavir

Dose: 200 mg TID, 400 mg TID, 600 mg TID, 300 mg BID

Effect: Inconsistent effect across all dosing regimens; No effect on AUC with clinical abacavir dose of 300mg BID



Effect: No significant change

Study 2 of 2

Abacavir

Dose: 600 mg x 1 dose

Effect: No significant change

Zidovudine

Dose: 300 mg x 1 dose

Effect: Zidovudine Cmax decreased 20%; AUC no significant change

Mechanism: Delayed zidovudine absorption
